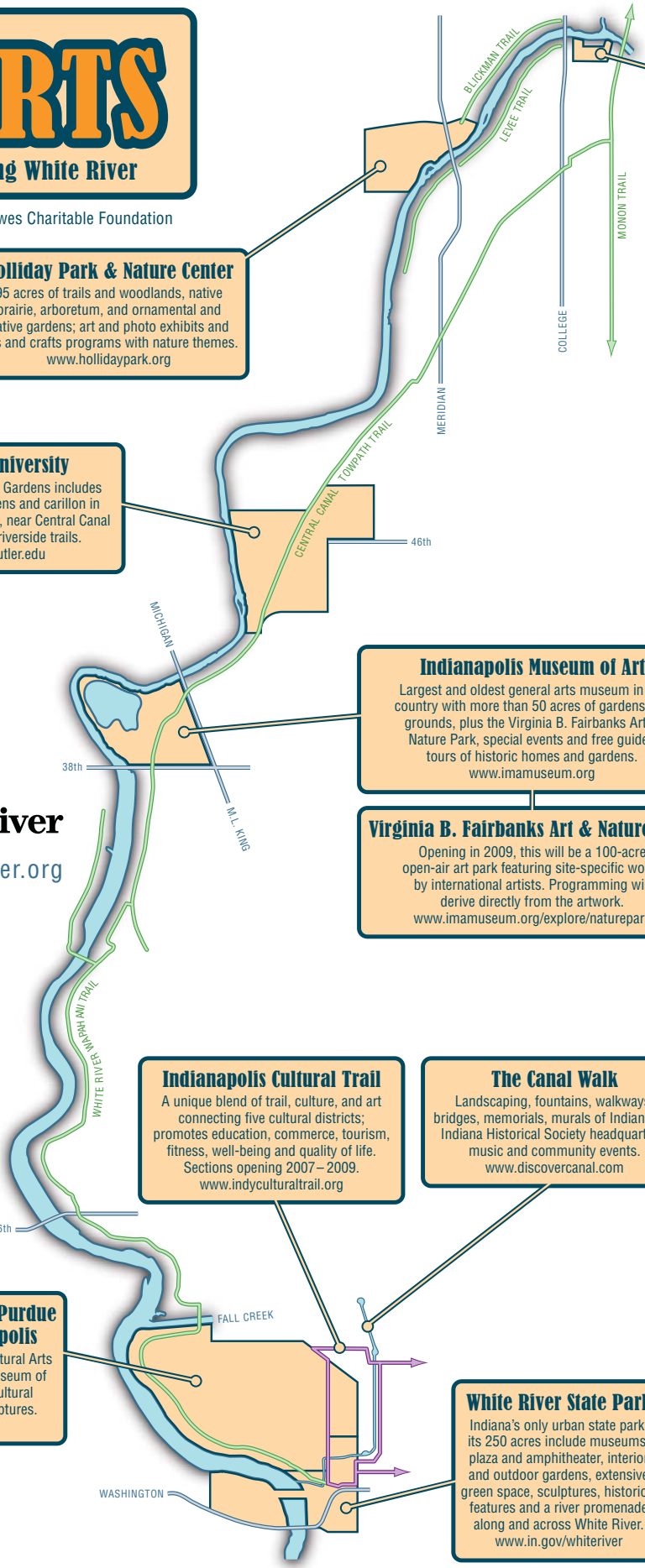
**Indiana State Museum**
